




Timeline for Health Care Reform Implementation


2010

- ❁ Insurance companies will not be able to deny children policies because of a “pre-existing condition.”
- ❁ New plans must provide preventive health services at no cost
- ❁ Community Health Centers receive new funding
- ❁ Insurance companies will not be able to cancel a policy if the holder gets sick




2011

- ❁ Private plans required to offer women’s preventive health services without co-pays
- ❁ Insurers will not be able to set lifetime or unreasonable annual limits on amount of medical care they will cover



2013

- ❁ Medicaid reimbursements for primary care doctors will be increased



2014

- ❁ Insurance mandate begins
- ❁ Companies with 50 or more employees must offer coverage to employees
- ❁ Insurers cannot charge more for policies based on gender
- ❁ Subsidies to purchase insurance policies begin
- ❁ Medicaid expansion to 133% FPL
- ❁ Insurance companies will not be able to deny adults policies because of a “pre-existing condition.”
- ❁ Insurance Exchanges will become available
