



We unite to bring attention and an immediate end to the systemic violence and discrimination the trans community faces daily. We demand an end to all legislation that criminalizes the existence of our trans hermanxs and encourage policymakers and organizations to create fundamental changes that foster inclusivity and community-building. #MyRJStory #LatinxPower
- We demand the protection and fulfillment of reproductive health rights and access for all people, including contraceptive equity and abortion. We demand available and affordable pre- and post-natal care, paid family leave, and respect for all parents regardless of age, gender identity, sexuality, and class. We demand that all people be able to access the healthcare they need without fear of encountering discriminatory practices and providers and without the threat of criminalization or incarceration, which is too often inflicted upon immigrants and people of color._#MyRJStory #LatinxPower
