

Texas Community Engagement Intern Job Description

Organizational Description: Founded in 1994, the National Latina Institute for Reproductive Justice (Latina Institute) builds Latina/x power to fight for the fundamental human right to reproductive health, dignity, and justice. We center and elevate Latina/x voices, mobilize our communities, transform the cultural narrative, and drive policy change. We amplify the grassroots power and thought leadership of Latinas/xs across the country to fuel a larger reproductive justice movement.

Position Description: Latina Institute Texas seeks an intern to support our Community Mobilization's Texas team in its day-to-day community engagement activities. This includes supporting the base building strategies of the Texas team and maintaining our state social media presence in Texas. Over the course of 20 hours a week, the intern will assist our Texas team in various tasks such as administrative, digital engagement, and civic engagement activities.

Reporting to the Texas Associate Director, the ideal candidate works well in teams, is passionate about organizing to elevate Latina/x power in the state and is tech-savvy.

Location: Texas (Hybrid/Remote)

Employee Status: Temporary/Part-Time, Non-Exempt, 20 hours per week
Flexible schedule of Monday - Friday

Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):

- Preparing and collecting meeting and event materials.
- Entering meeting and event data into Every Action.
- Organizing and outreach activities to include:
 - Talking to community members about reproductive justice issues.
 - Promote engagement with the Latina Institute Texas through volunteerism and civic participation.
- Assist TX Field Organizers with volunteer and activist recruitment and follow-up for campaign and outreach efforts as well as other events more broadly.
- Participate in and support GOTV (Get Out the Vote) activities.
- Work with Texas team to create online content for social media, newsletters, etc.
- Assist with other duties as assigned.

What You Will Need to Be Successful:

- Well-organized, detail-oriented, and self-motivated.
- Strong written and interpersonal communication and relationship-building skills.
- Commitment to reproductive justice and other intersecting social justice issues.

- Cultural competency and experience working with Latina/x communities.
- Knowledgeable about social media platforms (Facebook and Twitter)
- Experience managing volunteers is a plus.
- Must be comfortable communicating directly with voters.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Written and oral communication skills in English and Spanish.
